- Understand the importance of leadership and modelling the way, inspiring a shared vision of restorative practices
- Interpret different methods and strategies involved in implementing and creating restorative culture
- Examine different methods and strategies involved in implementation and application in school communities
- Develop practical tools for supporting collaboration and inclusiveness in school self-evaluation (SSE) processes
- Develop and design a strategy to implement and embed restorative culture within school communities to support safe, healthy and purposeful learning environments, and sustain them through effective restorative practices.
