- Apply RP processes and practices to support teaching practice and learning and the aims of the Primary and Post-Primary Curriculum
- Explore RP application in classrooms, offering a comprehensive systems-based understanding of wellbeing
- Develop effective restorative practices to support students' educational, social and personal wellbeing
- Develop practical tools for supporting collaboration and inclusiveness in school self-evaluation (SSE) processes
- Explore the potential of a restorative approach for creating and maintaining a positive relational environment in the classroom and school community.
